- 7. Follow the correct indents and spacing.

- 9. Place your last name and page number in the header and use a lower-case Roman numeral.
- 10. You should have at least 5 Roman numerals. The other letters and numbers will be different for each person, but greater depth will yield a better grade.
- 11. Though formatted properly, given its limited detail and absence of examples, this outline would likely earn a "C."
