- Contains Title (in Title Case)
- Begins with *revised* thesis statement
- Topic Outline Format and Parallel Structure
- Proper MLA Formatting
  - Double Spaced and One-inch Margins
  - Typed in 12-point Times New Roman
  - Paginated in Header by Last Name and Lower-case Roman Numeral
- MLA Conventions
  - Proper Categorization (i.e., Roman Numerals, Capital Letters, Numbers, etc.)
  - At Least Two Subdivisions for Each Category (i.e., every A has a B, every 1 has a 2)
  - Proper Indentation
- Capitalization and Spelling
- Grammar and Mechanics
- Ideas Follow Working Outline
- Ideas Are Clearly Relevant to Thesis
- Sufficient depth and Logically Sequenced
  - Works from big to small: broad concepts >> specific ideas >> concrete examples
  - Roman Numerals >> Capital Letters >> Numbers >> Lower-Case Letters
